The Montana Financial Education Coalition (MFEC) is seeking quality financial education program, curriculum and/or resource providers to present 40-minute workshops at the 2020 MFEC Statewide Conference & Resource. This is your opportunity to reach the major players in the financial education professions in Montana. Up to 9 providers will be selected to present workshops at the Conference. Workshops may include more than one presenter. Workshop selection criteria will include, without reference to priority, quality of program or resources, experience and success in using the program or resources, evaluation methodology, availability of the program or resources to other users, and quality of implementation instruction to be provided in the workshop. Workshops will also be selected to ensure a range of demographic target groups. Hot topics include K-12 and Senior/Care Giver Financial Education but any subject will be considered.

Providers selected to present at the conference will receive a complimentary conference registration and an exhibit booth at no cost.

The Conference is intended to provide attendees with information about the many excellent financial education resources available for all ages and demographics, as well as practical instruction for implementation. In addition to program workshops, the conference will host a Financial Education Resource Fair. The Fair offers an additional opportunity for financial education program, curricula or resource providers to exhibit their resources to Conference attendees. Attendees educated on how to apply for MFEC mini grants to purchase and implement financial education programs showcased in the Conference workshops and Resource Fair.
